Nonetheless, we are using other avenues to get the signed OP-CR01s, such as FedEx, etc. to the Responsible Officials homes for signatures, even though this poses additional exposure as well, but serves as the next best expeditious route to get the necessary documents to the Agency.

I do hope the Agency will further look into Guidance around electronic signatures as EPA and even the IRS utilizes electronic signatures, not just for COVID-19, but even during ‘normal’ business operations.

Again, at this juncture, Covestro retracts our latest request. Thanks for your attention and time in considering our request.

Hello Mr. Simon,

The possible examples of the OP-CR01 submissions you listed (i.e., permit applications, public notice requirements, deviation reporting) are helpful in reviewing this enforcement discretion request. However, the request needs to be more specific regarding the actual submissions Covestro, LLC is not able to provide with an original signature (OP-CR01) due to COVID-19 limitations. Also, you state that facility administrative and management personnel are primarily working, but is it still possible for Covestro personnel to provide the original signatures via the OP-CR01? We have seen fewer enforcement discretion requests like this one now that "stay-at-home" orders have been lifted. Please provide the following information: 1) a list of specific submissions that require the original signatures on the OP-CR01 form; 2) the expected dates/duration/reporting period associated to each submission; and 3) the rule citation that Covestro is requesting enforcement discretion due to an inability to comply based on COVID-19 limitations.

Good Afternoon Ramiro, et. al.,

I am submitting this request to seek authorization on behalf of Covestro LLC, requesting authorization to utilize electronic signatures in lieu of original signatures on any of our OP-CR01(s) for various Agency (TCEQ) submissions requiring the accompaniment of an OP-CR01 (e.g., permit applications, public notice requirements, deviation reporting, etc.) during the continued working from home/social distancing requirements of COVID-19? Previously, we only requested authorization for submitting our semi-annual reporting, but now request the same authorization for other Agency correspondences/documentation/packages during COVID-19 while our facility administrative and management personnel are primarily working remotely.

If granted, please advise if we need to submit an additional notation on the documentation or submit additional copies to other Agency personnel?
