The TCEQ has received your October 14, 2020, request for enforcement discretion to suspend monitoring requirements associated with the DFW Airport Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan for DFW's TPDES Permit No. TXR05U021 thru March 10, 2021. We understand that meeting the requirements of visual monitoring can be challenging; however, the visual monitoring is required to be conducted once during the quarter. The enforcement discretion you received in July provided ample time to coordinate the required visual monitoring while still meeting safety precautions related to COVID19.
