Good afternoon,

Due to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, Nalco Company, Fresno Facility (RN10161882) is respectfully requesting support from the TCEQ enforcement discretion for an extended deadline with regards to 2019 Point Source Emissions Inventory (EI) reporting from the March 31st deadline per 30 TAC 101.10(e). **Our request is for a two week extension; our 2019 EIs to be submitted on or before April 15, 2020 without penalty.**

Implementing CDC guidelines, the facility is working with a skeleton crew on-site; resultantly, is limited in capacity to pull all necessary data on-site. For the safety of our employees, we have limited our environmental engineers onsite that would have regularly pulled the data needed to complete this report. Nalco Company is diligently working with our reduced workforce to report the information in a timely manner by utilizing other members of our staff. Consequently this has caused a delay in gathering the needed information. The two week extension would allow us to coordinate our efforts for data analysis, prepare accurate reports and maintain compliance with environmental regulations and permit requirements.
