Good afternoon, Mr. Jaini:

The TCEQ has evaluated your request to extend the enforcement discretion (due to COVID-19 related challenges) previously approved on September 24, 2020, which is currently valid through December 31, 2020.

This enforcement discretion relates to performance testing of emission point numbers 26-CS (26.1 Hydrotreater heater), 29.1-36-001 (Vacuum Distillation Unit, Heater), 29.2-CS (Coker Heater), 28.2-36-2 (Unit 28.2 SRU), 38-36-251 (ULSD Charge Heater), and 38-36-252 (Stripper Reboiler Heater), as required by Special Condition 18 of Permit 5920A. In addition, this discretion will also be applicable for emission point numbers 39.1-95-118 and 3-95-3.

The TCEQ will extend this enforcement discretion to no later than March 31, 2021. The required tests shall be completed as soon as practicable, as conditions allow, by this date.

Please maintain records adequate to document activities related to any noncompliance under enforcement discretion, including details of Phillips 66 best efforts to comply.

We are resubmitting our compliance demonstration extension request based on October 9, 2020. conference call guidance. Phillips 66 previously submitted a September 10, 2020 written extension for compliance demonstration for several combustion sources due to demand being negatively impacted by COVID-19. We are requesting permission for extension for the following sources (EPNs) impacted by the situation, including 39.1-95-118, which has since been added to the list for the same reason:

- EPN 26-CS
- EPN 29.1-36-001
- EPN 29.2-CS
- EPN 28.2-36-2
- EPN 38-36-252
- EPN 39.1-95-118
- EPN 3-95-3

Our original plans were to retest these sources beginning second quarter of 2021 provided that the demand becomes normal. During the October 9, 2020 meeting, we had reached an agreement to resubmit this extension request, since COVID-19 negatively impacted the demand. Our plans have not changed and are still to retest these sources beginning second quarter of 2021.
