


Why Remove this Pollutant(s) from the APWL?

Benzene
 Benzene was placed on APWL1002 in Beaumont because annual benzene concentrations exceeded our previous long-term screening value of 1.0 ppb_v at the former CAMS 54 Carroll St. Park air monitoring site beginning in 2003 (see graph). However, based on TCEQ updated long-term screening value 1.4 ppb_v historical annual average benzene concentrations are below levels of concern. Thus, we are recommending that this pollutant be removed from APWL1002. Furthermore, TCEQ is in the process of relocating the former CAMS 54 air monitoring site to a nearby residential location in Beaumont just outside the expansion being created by the ExxonMobil facility. The TCEQ will resume air quality evaluations in this area once the new location is up and running.
